THE TRUTH

Sixty-Seven (67) people died from drugs or alcohol in Harford County in the past two years.

One Thousand, One Hundred Seven (1,107) people received DWI, DUI, or Alcohol citations in the county in 2008.

The top 5 drugs of choice in the county last year were (1) Alcohol, (2) Marijuana, (3) Heroin, (4) Crack, (5) Oxycodone.

Of the more than 2,000 Drug Treatment Admissions in Harford County in 2007 over 27% of them were Bel Air Residents.

Nationwide in 2008, Underage Drinking killed more than 5,000 young people below the age of 21.

FIFTY-NINE (59) Harford County Residents have died from Prescription Drugs over the past 3 years
